Appellation Texas Hill Country
Soil Consisting of clay and loam on top of weathered limestone, it's deep and rich in nutrients due to the Onion Creek flooding over the years.

Varieties Grenache 21%, Syrah 48%, Mourvèdre 31%

Comments

Our GSM is an Old-World blend showcasing vibrant New-World fruit characteristics and distinct expressions of Texas Hill country terroir. Syrah takes center stage revealing lively blackberry and blueberry flavors accented with notes of jerky, violet, lavender, anise and a generous dose of crushed black pepper. The Mourvèdre enriches the blend with subtle earth tones, and the Grenache adds a soft hint of black cherry. Enjoy!
